Future Vehicle Maintenance and Storage Facility & Western Alignment Update for Keele Street to Jane Street

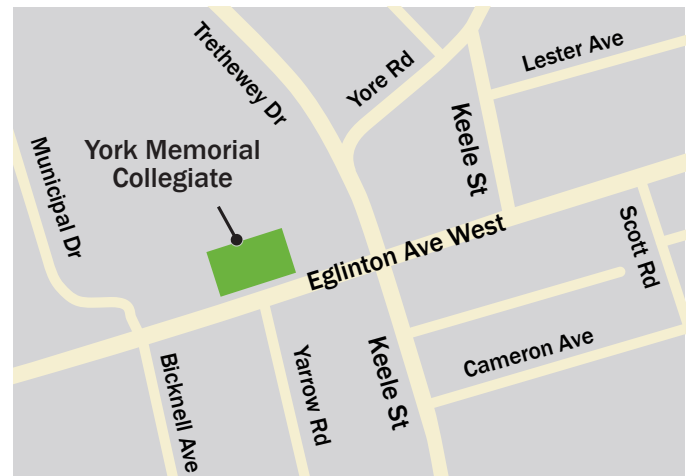
Rapid and reliable transit is coming to Eglinton. The Crosstown will move Torontonians to work, school and play faster than ever before – reducing travel times and enhancing our economy and our environment. Once complete, an underground trip from Keele Street to Yonge Street will only take 15 minutes.

Metrolinx and the TTC invite you to attend an Open House to learn about a number of new developments and improvements for the project and to share your input on preliminary plans for:

- The future Light Rail Vehicle Maintenance and Storage Facility at the former Kodak Lands
- Route alignment from west of Keele Street to the former Kodak Lands and extension of the line to Jane Street, including underneath Weston Road
- A new Crosstown station near Weston Road

Metrolinx staff will provide an introduction to the Mobility Hub Study, updates on tunnel construction plans and the future Keelesdale Park Bridge.

The open house will provide an opportunity to view displays, submit comments and speak 1 on 1 with the design team. This preliminary open house will be followed by additional consultations in the Fall.
